Website revisions 03.01.2023

- **Calendar Committee**
 - University Week
 - Communication of calendar
 - Finals week MTRF with W being a study day; final grades due by 3:00 on M after finals
 - Graduation application period extended
- **Academic Structures**
 - Re-evaluate the departments housed within each college, particularly our outlying programs in human and social sciences.
 - Re-evaluate titles, stipends, job duties, and course releases for consistency
 - Reconsider the school structure to improve faculty development initiatives

Meauxmentum Summit Objective

All participating institutions and systems will design an institutional strategy and initial 30, 60, and 90 plans for implementing the Louisiana Meauxmentum Approach at their institutions by Fall, 2024.

Summit Outcomes

- Expand steering committee
- Review data governance and protocols
- Develop communication plans
- Expand use of MyMajors
- Advance ULM's identity as a regional and state resource
- Continue with the Centennial Scholars program
- Review scholarship strategies directed toward increasing need-based
- Develop a curricular/career mentor model

Summit Outcomes

- Fully establish Math Pathways
- Develop metamajor or thematic pathways
- Review best practices for academic mentoring
- Catalog external partnerships
- Ensure students attempt 9 hrs within the metamajor or major in their first year
- Hire the Director of the Faculty and Staff Professional Development Center
- Review safety protocols for after business hours

Summit Outcomes

- Create process for ensuring students complete first ENGL and MATH in first year
- Gateway course analysis
- Course/Grade policy review
- Review and revise UNIV 1001
- Develop a holistic first year experience
 - Integrate PREP/POP more into new FYE
 - Review the role of the Student Success Center in new FYE
 - Review the role of Student Life in new FYE
 - Celebrate milestones
- Incorporate universally e-portfolio usage
