FIRST AMENDMENT

to

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

NORTHCENTRAL TECHNICAL COLLEGE

and

UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA AT MONROE

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (Amendment) is in regards to that certain Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Northcentral Technical College (NTC) and the University of Louisiana at Monroe (ULM) executed the 23rd day of February, 2012, a copy of which, together with any and all amendments made subsequent to such MOU, is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

This Amendment shall be effective on August 27, 2014 and shall serve to amend the MOU as further described herein. Unless modified by this Amendment or otherwise, all other provisions of the MOU and amendments thereto shall remain in effect.

NTC and ULM now desire to amend the MOU as follows:

- 1) Appendix D (Intent to Participate in 2+2 Program) is amended and/or revised as follows:
 - a. The Other Name section is revised by deleting the word "Last"; and adding the letter "s" to the word "Name". The revised section shall state as follows: Other Names Used
 - b. The Ethnicity section is amended to add the following language: This information is voluntary and will be used in a non-discriminatory manner consistent with civil rights laws.
- 2) Provisions have been amended as follows:
 - a. A Provision stating, "ULM agrees that NTC shall not be responsible for any act or omission of ULM, its employees, agents and/or students. NTC agrees that ULM shall not be responsible for any act or omission of ULM, its employees, agents and/or students.
- 3) Bachelor of Science Degree Completion in Dental Hygiene Courses to be taken at ULM has been amended as follows:
 - a. Credit hours for DHYG 4030 Problems have been changed from 3 credit hours to 2 credit hours.
 - b. DHYG 4033 Local Anesthesia has been removed from the list of courses.
 - c. GERO 2026 Perspectives on Aging has been added to the list of courses.
