This degree program is 30 credit hours. Graduate Assistantships are available to qualified students.

Those students entering the program will be required to complete a core curriculum and then may choose one of the following areas of specialization:

- Aging Studies
- Long-term Care Administration
- Grief Care Management
- Health Care Management

A Graduate Certificate in Senior Healthcare Management will provide skills and training to address growing healthcare needs. This 15 credit hour online certificate consists of gerontology and business coursework designed to enhance your knowledge and working skills to better serve the aging population.
