

Creating & Managing Homepage Alerts

webservices.ulm.edu/apps

Access the alert tool at the above address.

Log in using your username & password
- ex: jdoe@ulm.edu > username is "jdoe"

Select Home Alert

By default you will be under the edit tab on the resulting screen

Alert Text: Enter the text for the warning
- use plain text only

Status: select either enabled or disabled

Date: if the alert is enabled, you can set an end date to automatically turn it off

Click within the date field to edit

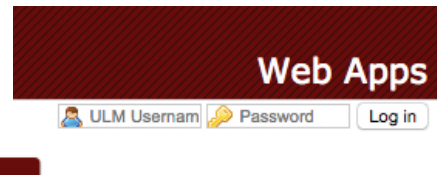
If **no end** date is desired, **clear** the date field
select & delete date

Time: if an end date is set, select a time

Key in the time or use up or down keyboard arrows for hour, minutes & am/pm selection

Log: (optional)

Remember to **Save** when finished
