

AN ACT

To approve an agreement between the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College and the Ouachita Parish School Board establishing a Northeast Center of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana, That a certain agreement between the Ouachita Parish School Board and the Board of Supervisors of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College of the date of July 28, 1933, establishing at Monroe, Louisiana, a branch or center of learning of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, be, and the same is, hereby approved; provided, that the approval of said agreement herein given and the operation thereof shall be and is hereby limited to a period of three years.

Establishing Northeast Center of Louisiana State University at Monroe, La.

Section 2. All corporate authority and all powers of supervision and regulation, internal and otherwise, now vested in the Board of Supervisors to manage the University shall extend to all its extensions and branches or centers of learning as now existing or as may hereafter be established whatsoever. Provided, that the curriculum to be offered at said branch or center of learning shall be strictly limited by said Board of Supervisors to the subjects which are included or which may hereafter be included in the curriculum of the Lower Division or to the subjects of the first two years of college work now or hereafter to be offered in the College of Arts and Sciences of the Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge.

Under supervision of Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College.

Section 3. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as in any manner limiting the corporate capacity and authority of the Board of Supervisors of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College as heretofore established by the Constitution and laws of Louisiana.

Not to affect existing authority.
